This year the Regional Christian Singles Camping Weekend will be held June 21st – 23rd at [Hunt Hill Audubon Sanctuary](#) near Sarona, WI. Activities include volleyball, badminton, canoeing, kayaking, hiking, bonfire, and more! The cost is \$75 per person and includes lodging, meals, coffee, and a devotional booklet.

Schedule & Activities

Registered campers will be expected to arrive and confirm their reservation between 6 pm to 7 pm at Hunt Hill Audubon Sanctuary on Friday, June 21st. Feel free to eat before you arrive. There will be snacks Friday night and a meet and greet to welcome everyone and introduce the weekend.

Saturday will feature a continental breakfast at 8:30 AM, lunch at Noon, and dinner at 5 PM. There will also be prayer and devotional time before or after each meal, which campers will be expected to attend. Between meals, various activities will be available including volleyball, badminton, canoeing, kayaking, hiking, and bonfire. Cards and board games will also be available.

On Sunday, we will have a continental breakfast at 7:30 AM along with one final devotion together, say our goodbyes, and depart around 8:30 AM, so those who want to attend their home church services can still do so.

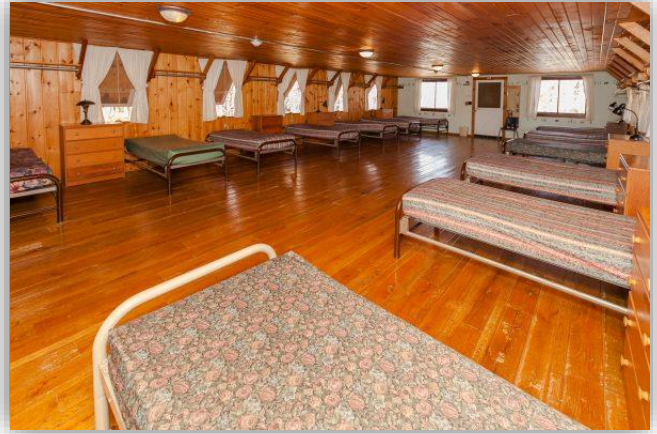
The Blind Munchies Coffeehouse will provide coffee throughout the weekend, included with your registration.

Guidelines

No firearms, drugs, or alcohol will be permitted on the grounds. No pets or children will be allowed at this event as we seek to provide a weekend with as few of distractions as possible. Quiet hours will start at 10 PM each evening with absolute silence by 11 PM, for the respect of the other campers.

Dorms & Showers

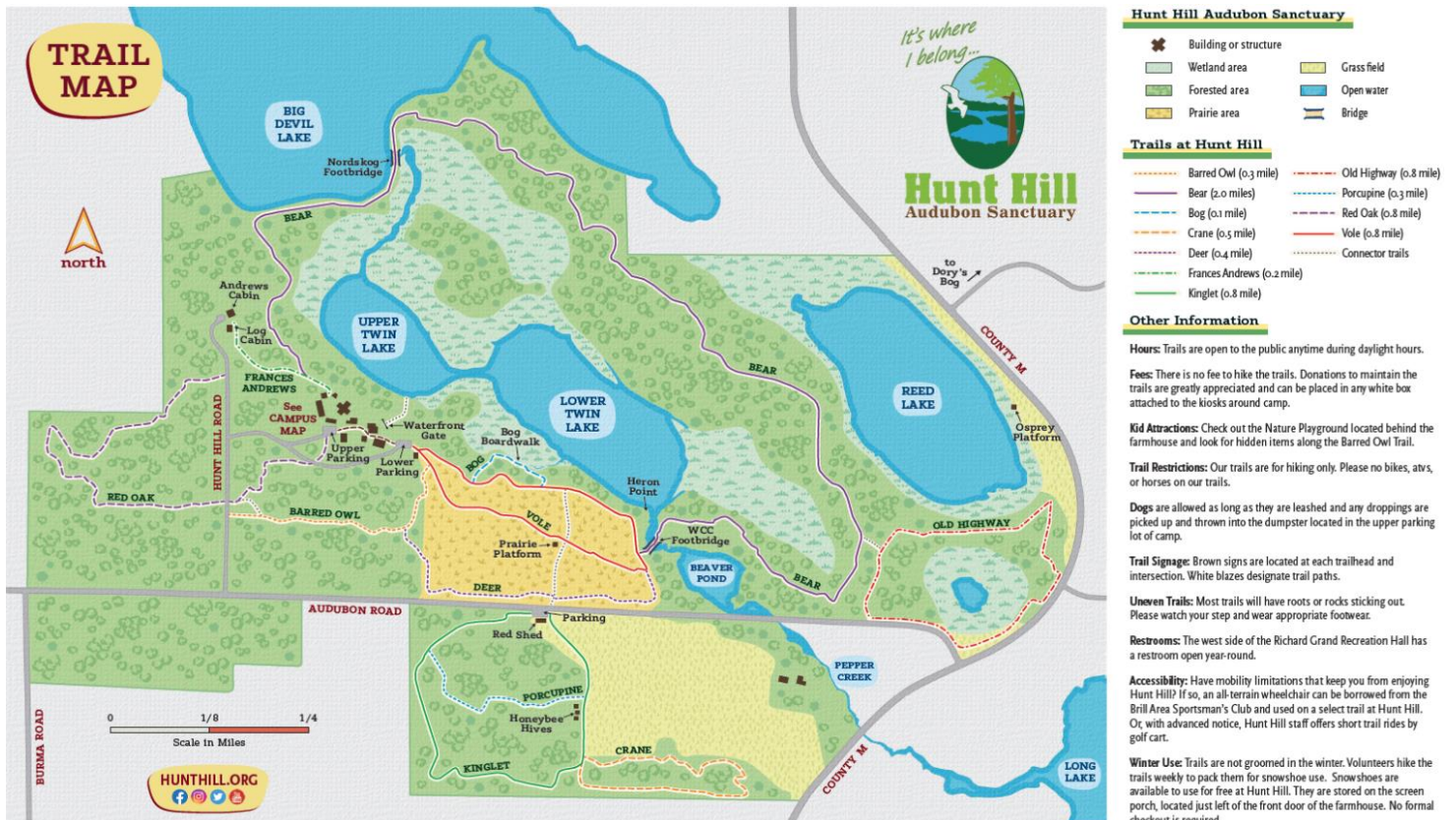
Dorms will be reserved on an as-needed basis, with single beds for up to 70 guests. Campers will be assigned to a men's or women's dorm room upon registering. Dorms are comprised of comfortable group rooms holding 7-12 guests per room. Cross Dorm can sleep up to 45 guests in four large wings. Long Dorm sleeps up to 36 guests in 17 rooms. You will need to provide your own bedding/sleeping bag and pillow.



Both dorms have a men's and women's bathroom, with a new shower building, just a few steps away. The shower house includes men's and women's sides with multiple toilets, sinks, changing stalls, and showers.
